

Wagner Reese Steps Forward to Represent First Victim of Indiana EMT Sexual Assault Case

[CARMEL, Indiana] July 15, 2026 — Wagner Reese, a personal injury law firm based in Carmel, Indiana, is representing the first known victim to come forward in a case involving an Indiana EMT accused of sexually assaulting a teenager during an ambulance transport. Their courage in doing so is commendable and may be critical in bringing further cases to light.

Ronald D. Elliott Jr., an EMT employed by Quest Ambulance Service, faces multiple felony charges, including sexual misconduct with a minor, child seduction, vicarious sexual gratification, and child solicitation, following allegations that he sexually assaulted a minor while on duty in Indiana.

Elliott has now been charged again in connection with allegations involving another teenager in the back of an ambulance that predate the first known victim's alleged assault, raising serious questions as to whether his employer had notice of Elliott's inappropriate and unlawful conduct, failed to take reasonable action to prevent further abuse, and whether additional victims have yet to come forward.
